<p align="center">CITY OF NEBRASKA CITY, NEBRASKA ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM AND FUNDING PROPOSITION 1</p> <p align="center">REVISE AND EXTEND NEBRASKA CITY'S ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM</p> <p>Pursuant to the City of Nebraska City's Economic Development Program qualified businesses may apply for funding assistance for eligible activities with goals of creating and retaining jobs and employment opportunities, supporting existing businesses, stimulating downtown revitalization, attracting new investment to the community, broadening the tax base to reduce the citizens' property tax burden, and enhancing the tourism industry to provide overall economic growth for Nebraska City. This Program shall be in existence for ten years with the funding allocated from existing local option sales tax collections from 2017 through 2027. The estimated annual allocation for the ten-year period is \$250,000 per year.
