

The Otoe County Board of Commissioners convened at 8:30 a.m. on Tuesday, April 28, 2020 in the Otoe County Courtroom (108) of the Courthouse in Nebraska City and by the online Zoom platform. Minutes of the previous meeting were not read as each Board Member was furnished with copies of the same. Members present were Jerad Sornson, Rick Freshman, James Parsons, Dean Speth and Jim Thurman. The following motions were passed by majority vote: to approve a conditional use permit for a new cell tower on a site located in the S ½ , of the NW ¼ of S 27, T 7N, R 14E; to approve the subdivision plat of R. Steinhoff located in part of the SE ¼ of the SW ¼ of S 21, T 9N, R 11E; to approve resolution 4-28-20-16 authorizing county credit cards; to approve the use of the Courthouse lawn for National Day of Prayer; to approve signing a letter of support for the expansion of Hwy 75 to four lanes through Otoe Co; to approve and sign resolution 4-28-20-15 authorizing regulations for the prevention of spread of communicable diseases, illness or poisoning.
