Special Meeting Otoe County Board of Commissioners September 15, 2020

The Board of Commissioners of Otoe County met in Special Session on September 15, 2020, at 8:30 a.m. in the Courtroom of the Otoe County Courthouse. Advance notice of said meeting was provided to the Nebraska City News Press and posted in several public places. This meeting was open to the public and the agenda was kept current and is on file for public inspection at the office of the Otoe County Clerk during regular business hours.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman of the Board, Jerad Sornson. Answering present at roll call were Commissioners Jerad Sornson, Rick Freshman, Dean Speth, and Jim Thurman. Absent – Commissioner Parsons. Chairman Sornson informed the public in attendance that a current copy of the Open Meetings Act is posted in the Courtroom.

Commissioner Freshman made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Thurman to accept the agenda as posted. Voting aye were Commissioners Sornson, Freshman, Speth and Thurman. Nay - none. Motion carried.

Commissioner Thurman made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Speth to accept the minutes from the last meeting. Voting aye were Commissioners Freshman, Speth, Thurman and Sornson. Nay - none. Motion carried.

Chairman Sornson introduced Resolution 9-15-20-31 that allows the Board to increase restricted funds an extra 1% in addition to the statutory allowance of 2.5% limit. Commissioner Freshman made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Thurman to adopt and sign the resolution to increase restricted funds by 1%. Chairman Sornson called for a vote. Voting aye were Commissioners Speth, Thurman, Sornson and Freshman. Nay – none. Motion carried.

Chairman Freshman made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Speth, to approve and sign Resolution 9-15-20-32 adopting the proposed budget for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 as presented. Chairman Sornson called for a vote. Voting aye were Commissioners Thurman, Sornson, Freshman and Speth. Nay – none. Motion carried.

Chairman Sornson declared the meeting adjourned at 8:33 a.m.
