

Board of Equalization
June 23, 2020

At 8:25 a.m. a meeting of the Board of Equalization was called to order by Chairman Jerad Sornson. Answering present at roll call were Commissioner Sornson, Commissioner Freshman, Commissioner Parsons, Commissioner Speth and Commissioner Thurman.

Chairman Sornson informed the public in attendance that a current copy of the Open Meetings Act is posted on the south wall of the Courtroom.

Commissioner Freshman made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Thurman to accept the agenda as posted. There being no further discussion Chairman Sornson called for a vote. Voting aye were Commissioners Sornson, Freshman, Parsons, Speth, and Thurman. Nay – none. Motion carried.

Commissioner Freshman made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Thurman to accept the minutes from the previous meeting and not have them read as each member was furnished with a copy of same. There being no further discussion, Chairman Sornson called for a vote. Voting aye were Commissioners Freshman, Parsons, Speth, Thurman, and Sornson. Nay – none. Motion carried.

Chairman Sornson opened a public hearing for permissive exemption applications submitted by Church of Christ of Nebraska City for parcels #004680500 and #004679000. Christi Smallfoot, County Assessor, stated that applications were filed after the deadline and the penalty amount is \$800.00. The Assessor's recommendation is to approve the applications. Commissioner Parsons made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Freshman to agree with the Assessor's recommendation and approve the permissive exemption applications. Voting aye were Commissioners Parsons, Speth, Thurman, Sornson and Freshman. Nay – none. Motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time, and since all items on the agenda have been disposed of, Chairman Sornson declared the meeting adjourned at 8:29 a.m.
