

Board of Equalization  
October 12, 2021

At 8:25 a.m. a meeting of the Board of Equalization was called to order by Chairman Jerad Sornson. Answering present at roll call were Commissioner Sornson, Commissioner Freshman, Commissioner Parsons, Commissioner Thurman, and Commissioner Crownover. Absent – none.

Chairman Sornson informed the public in attendance that a current copy of the Open Meetings Act is posted on the south wall of the Courtroom.

Freshman made a motion, seconded by Parsons to accept the agenda as posted. Voting aye were Sornson, Freshman, Parsons, Thurman, and Crownover. Nay – none. Motion carried.

Parsons made a motion, seconded by Thurman to accept the minutes from the previous meeting and not have them read as each member was furnished with a copy of same. Voting aye were Freshman, Parsons, Thurman, Crownover, and Sornson. Nay – none. Motion carried.

Christi Smallfoot, County Assessor, presented the following tax list corrections to the board: 1) Personal property ID #453203510 – deduct \$183.22 from tax year 2020– clerical error; 2) OPPD – deduct \$168.29 from tax year 2020 – correction to balance treasurer’s receipt for actual taxes collected for 2020. Freshman made a motion, seconded by Crownover, to approve the tax list corrections as presented. Voting aye were Commissioners Parsons, Thurman, Crownover, Sornson, and Freshman. Nay – none. Motion carried.

Parsons made a motion, seconded by Freshman, to adopt Resolution #10-12-21-24 to set the levies for taxing entities within Otoe County for 2021. Voting aye were Thurman, Crownover, Sornson, Freshman, and Parsons. Nay – none. Motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time, and since all items on the agenda have been disposed of, Chairman Sornson declared the meeting adjourned at 8:27 a.m.
